ViewRay Receives Matching Funds Grant

ViewRay today announced that it has just received a matching funds grant from the *Florida High Tech Corridor Council (FHTCC) Matching Funds Research Program*. This important funding will support certain mechanical engineering aspects of the Renaissance(TM). Work will be done under the direction of ViewRay collaborator John C. Ziegert, Ph.D., who is the University of Florida Ebaugh Professor of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering & Director of the Machine Tool Research Center .

The Florida Legislature established the FHTCC in 1996 to attract, retain and grow key high tech industries. The FHTCC fosters applied research between the universities and their high tech industry partners. During its first eight years, the FHTCC provided over \$120 million to 215 companies for more than 550 research projects, with university and industry scientists and engineers working side-by-side.

ViewRay CEO Russ Donda adds, “We are glad the FHTCC believes in what we are doing; moreover we are excited to have John Ziegert on board.”
